How Cool Is This? An Icy, Easy Pour

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This sleek, well-designed new carafe from Germany would be worth owning even if it did not come with a built-in cooler. The carafe is well balanced, holds a full liter and has a stopper with a cover that tilts to keep bugs out yet allows easy pouring.

HOW IT WORKS A black disc that resembles a hockey puck is stored in the freezer and then set into the base of the carafe. The disc contains a sealed gel pack. Iced tea that started out cold remained properly chilled without additional ice for more than three hours.
